In accordance with Temple Avodah's Constitution and By-Laws, a special meeting of the Congregation is being called and will be held on Thursday, February 28, 2019 at 7:00pm in the Social Hall.

All Congregants in good standing are permitted and encouraged to attend and vote at the meeting.

The agenda is as follows:

Motion to approve the amending of the Constitution and By-Laws of Temple Avodah to add the following provisions:

Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution of Temple Avodah is amended to add subsection (h) as follows:

Only one member of a family or of a committed relationship may concurrently serve in any position on the Executive Committee of Temple Avodah;

Article VI Section 1 of the Constitution of Temple Avodah is amended to add subsection (i) as follows:

The provision within subsection (h) of Article VI Section 1 permitting only one member of a family or of a committed relationship to concurrently serve in any position on the Executive Committee of Temple Avodah, shall not apply to family members or persons within committed relationships who are serving on the Executive Committee of Temple Avodah, at the time, subsection (h) of Article VI Section 1, is adopted to the Constitution of Temple Avodah
